VE Day Celebration

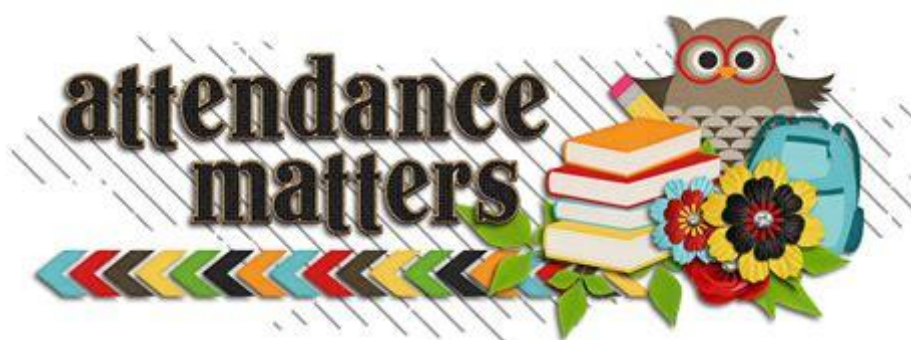
