Supporting families with the increasing costs of living



As we approach Christmas—a time that can be expensive for everyone—I want to reassure you that **school is here to help**. The purpose of this newsletter is to let you know that we can support families with the cost of anything related to school, whether that's educational visits, uniform or extra-curricular activities. **Discretion and confidentiality are guaranteed, whatever your circumstances.**

Our aim is to provide a balance of enriching experiences for our children without adding unnecessary financial pressure. We never want cost to be a barrier to participation or enjoyment. If you ever feel that something we are offering might cause a financial strain, please **get in touch with us**—we will always do our best to help. A quick chat, an email or a phone call is all it takes and we promise to handle everything sensitively and discreetly. This support may available to all families who need it not just those in receipt of free school meals.

We understand that the current cost of living can be challenging for many families. Whilst we have limited funds ourselves, we want to make sure that all of our children at Clover Hill has access to the same opportunities, regardless of financial circumstances.

As part of our universal education offer, we can provide support in several ways:

- Educational Visits: We can help subsidise the cost of visits for families with individual circumstances.
- **School Uniform:** If you need assistance with uniform, please let us know. We already have a small supply of good-quality pre-owned items and welcome further donations.
- Extra-Curricular Clubs: We can help with the cost of attending clubs so that all children can take part.

During the last week of term, we will have a **uniform stall in the playground** where parents can take any items they need, completely free of charge. If you are unable to attend, please contact us and we will do our best to source what you need and send it home discreetly in your child's bag.
