Each year, participants work for several weeks as a team tackling a shared project like real engineers. Our team of children will plan, design and program an autonomous LEGO® Education robot, conduct research on a self-chosen topic and create a presentation of their findings.

The FIRST Core Values - such as respectful interaction, shared experiences and critical thinking—are at the heart of the program. After several weeks of preparation, teams compete in regional and national tournaments to present their solutions. We will keep you updated with our progress.
